
Fruit and Vegetable Supplemental Benefit Programs Already in California (aka Healthy Food Incentive Programs)





With EBT integration, incentives are distributed via:

State-issued EBT card



And, at CA farmers' markets, the EBT card in conjunction with tokens





How it would work for customers at CA grocery stores with AB 605



Use your CalFresh card to buy fresh fruits and vegetables at a participating grocery store



Your purchase is matched, penny-for-penny, up to \$60 per month. The money is rebated back to your EBT account.




Spend your rebate/bonus dollars on any CalFresh eligible items (not just fruit and vegetables) at any future shopping trip.




Current pilot sites (going live in the next few months)

AB 605 would:

Increase the number of CalFresh participants who could access \$60/month extra in fruit and veg supplemental benefits

Expand the number and variety of retailers offering CalFresh Fruit and Veg Supplemental Benefits, focused on:

- Direct farm-to-consumer retailers (e.g. farmers markets)
- Small/Independent Grocery Stores and Chains
- Larger grocery chains
