What is "nutrition insecurity"? Nutrition insecurity" is not having reliable Hunger Coalition estimates the nutrition insecure population to be households with income below 200\% of Federal Poverty Level ( $\$ 60 \mathrm{~K} / \mathrm{year}$ for a family of 4 ). Res indicates this to be a conservative estimate of the population needing food assistance to obtain adequate daily nutrition
