Use this checklist to help you get ready for your interview. *You do not need everything* on the list and it is not a complete list, but it offers some suggestions about what kinds of documents you might need for verification. Bring these items to your SNAP (*Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program*; formerly *Food Stamp Program*) interview. Some documents can be used to verify more than one thing (for example, a utility bill can prove your residency and verify your utility expense). Your worker will tell you if you should provide any other documents. Even if you do not have all your verifications, *go to your appointment anyway!*
